<b>Resilience and innovation</b> 7 <sup>th</sup> or 8 <sup>th</sup> June Afternoon/evening	Discussing challenges on building resilience and cultivating innovation in e-governance through digital technologies.
	Work in assigned learning groups in Teams with tutor. Preparation: Watch the recorded lectures and read the articles related to the issues. End of session: Answer the online quiz.
<b>Democratic governance</b> 13 <sup>th</sup> or 15 <sup>th</sup> June Afternoon/evening	Discussing challenges on promoting democracy and fostering inclusion through digital innovations in e-governance.
	Work in assigned learning groups in Teams with tutor. Preparation: Watch the recorded lectures and read the articles related to the issues. End of session: Answer the online quiz.
<b>Best practice tutoring</b> 20 <sup>th</sup> or 21 <sup>st</sup> June Afternoon/evening	Tutors available for individual support for presentations of best practice and poster design.
	Preparation: Work on posters and use the lessons learned so far.
