### Bus

From Norrköping resecentrum adjacent to the train station, take **bus #432 at 9.20** to stop Fridhemsvägen Hammaren (18 minutes). Walk 500 m up the hill.

Tickets can be purchased for 60 SEK at the station. Please arrive early, as there is only one service window for purchases and the 9.20 bus is the last of the morning.

Return tickets can be purchased with cash on board. Return buses leave the conference site at 16.04, 16.37, 17.24, and 17.42
