18 - 19 November 2024 in Oviedo, Spain

Connect, engage and collaborate with other international students working on gender studies in a **two-day hybrid cohort meeting**. The meeting will be held on Microsoft Teams for online participants and at the University Institute on Gender and Diversity (Campus de El Milán, Oviedo) for in-person attendees. A link to the online meeting will be provided to participants in due time. We want to create a safe and open space where gender students in the InterGender consortium and from different academic fields can share their ideas, needs and concerns while reflecting on selected readings on coalitional research. DAY 1 **OPENING SESSION**

On the first day, the cohort meeting will be preceded by a colloquium meeting, during which we will focus on explaining and discussing the format and topics for a series of upcoming InterGender colloquia. The cohort meeting of that day will aim to facilitate interaction between all PhD and Master's Students of the InterGender consortium as they engage with prompts and questions centred around the idea of coalitions and other related concepts. Throughout the session, students are welcome to share their needs, concerns and ideas regarding the organisation.

DAY 2 FULL SESSION

19 November

On the second day, a final colloquium meeting will be held to review the conclusions of the previous day and finalise the format and list of topics. In the cohort meeting, the possibilities and expansiveness of researching gender from seemingly remote academic fields are further explored via selected readings that will be sent to participants prior to the session. On this day, we will also be joined by Dr. Lorgia García Peña, renowned author and professor of Black, Latinx Studies at the Department of African American Studies of Princeton University.


