  - Svenska som andraspråk basic course 30 ECTS, Svenska som andraspråk continuation course 30 ECTS credits, Svenska som andraspråk in-depth course 30 ECTS credits with 82,5 ECTS credits passed including academic paper
- English and Swedish corresponding to the level of English and Swedish in Swedish upper secondary education (Engelska 6 and Svenska)

### **Examination**

If the LiU coordinator for students with disabilities has granted a student the right to an adapted examination for a written examination in an examination hall, the student has the right to it. If the coordinator has instead recommended for the student an adapted examination or alternative form of examination, the examiner may grant this if the examiner assesses that it is possible, based on consideration of the course objectives.
